





Home Performance Contractor Network (HPCN) Requirements



HPCN Eligibility

- Be companies or independent contractors. Individual installers are not eligible to apply on their own.
- Directly employee their installers for the relevant sector. Membership in the HPCN does not cover sub-contractors.
- Be currently be operating in British Columbia and have been operating in British Columbia for a minimum of three (3) consecutive years before the date of application.

Qualifications

• Sector-specific: trade designations (as applicable) and training

Business Documentation & Agreement

- Submit: municipal/regional business licenses, proof of warrantee, updated insurance, and WorkSafeBC clearance letter
- Sign network agreement

Membership & Ongoing Management

- Displayed on the public search tool
- Access to subsidy reimbursements, network logo, networking
- Ongoing management


Home performance is a holistic approach to identifying and addressing homeowners' energy efficiency, comfort, health, and safety related issues to make a home perform better. It is estimated that nearly 500,000 single detached houses in BC may benefit from home performance upgrades. Whole home performance renovations in BC can assist utilities to meet energy conservation targets and governments to meet greenhouse gas reduction targets. Additionally, this multi-billion-dollar industry supports job creation and business development in communities across the province.


